

Regulations relating to prohibition on anchorage and fishing with certain types of gear around Snorre subsea installation. Stipulated by Royal Decree of 23 June 1989 by virtue of Royal Decree of 9 October 1987 relating to safety zones etc., Section 9, second paragraph. Last amended by Royal Decree of 18 March 1992.

Section 1

These regulations apply to an area around/above the subsea installation on Snorre, and the towhead, laying approximately 75 meters away from the installation, limited by a circle with a radius of 575 meters distance from the centre of the installation.

The position of the installation is as follows:

Section 2

Within the area described in Section 1 all unnecessary anchoring and fishing with trawls, trawl nets, purse-seines and other gear which may cause damage to installations on or above the seabed, is prohibited.

Section 3

Willful or negligent violation of these regulations is punishable pursuant to Act of 22 March 1985 No. 11 relating to petroleum activities, Section 66, and regulations relating to safety zones etc., Section 15.

Section 4

These regulations enter into force from the time the Ministry decides.
